

# **WATERING ALERT NOTICE!**

## **ALL OUTDOOR IRRIGATION FROM FRIDAY, JULY 17, 2009 THROUGH MONDAY, JULY 20, 2009 IS PROHIBITED**

Stage III of the Chisholm Trail's Drought Plan commences on July 20, 2009

**Excessive water use due to drought conditions has caused aquifer levels to drop to emergency levels. In order to conserve water and allow our wells and tanks to recover we need all outdoor watering to stop until Monday July 20, 2009.**

**Stage III Drought Plans requirements commencing July 20, 2009 authorize outdoor irrigation once per week as follows:**

Addresses with a number ending in 0 or 9 – Mondays only

Addresses with a number ending in 1 or 8 - Tuesdays only

Addresses with a number ending in 2 or 7 – Thursdays only

Addresses with a number ending in 3 or 6 – Fridays only

Addresses with a number ending in 4 or 5 – Sundays only

- This includes watering with hose-end sprinklers, automatic sprinklers, soaker hoses, or drip irrigation.
- The mandatory times for outside water remain between the hours of 12:00 midnight to 6:00A.M. or 7:00 P.M. to 12:00 midnight on your designated watering day. For example, if your designated day is Tuesday, you may water from midnight to 6 AM Tuesday morning **OR** from 7 PM to midnight Tuesday evening.

There shall be no outside landscape irrigation on Wednesdays or Saturdays, except that irrigation by hand-held buckets is permitted anytime.

Failure to comply with the District's drought restriction requirements may result in monetary fines and penalties.
